



Steps For Filing A Claim For Vandalism Damage

Comprehensive insurance generally covers the cost associated with vandalism damage, whether it is keyed cars, smashed headlights or broken windows.

2. Call Your Insurance Company

After filing the police report, call your insurance company as soon as possible and be prepared with the following to file a vandalism claim:

- Date and time at which the incident occurred.
- Description or pictures of the damaged vehicle.
- List of the items which were stolen from your vehicle.

4. Take Your Vehicle For Repair

You can get your vehicle repaired from a shop of your choice or go to the one that your insurance company has a tie-up with and get your vehicle repaired as soon as you can.



1. Notify The Police Right Away

Call police the moment you notice that your vehicle has been damaged and file a report to initiate the claim process.

3. Speak With Claims Adjuster

Once you file the claim, insurance company usually sends a claim adjuster to calculate the level of damage. So, follow all the instructions given by adjuster in order to qualify for your claim.
