


# RV Maintenance Tips For Low Insurance Premium



So, here are few tips to help you in maintaining your RV:




Inspect the roof regularly and be sure to seal any open seams to avoid leakage through them.

Lubricate the slide-out rails twice a year to prevent deterioration caused by rust and corrosion.



Keep an eye on the battery levels of the RV and charge them properly when due.
