

6 Terms You Should Know About RV Insurance



RV insurance provides financial coverage to the owners of recreational vehicles. Common RV insurance terms are:

1

Classes Of RV

Recreational vehicles include a wide range of motor homes, camper vans, etc. organized into classes i.e. Class A, B, and C.

2

Coverage

The amount of protection and benefits you choose in your RV insurance plan, for example, collision coverage, liability coverage, etc.

3

Declarations Page

It is the first page of RV insurance documents that specifies details of coverage including coverage limits and deductibles.

4

Deductibles

It is the amount of money that an RV insurance holder is responsible to pay out of his pocket when a loss occurs before the insurance plan pays off.

5

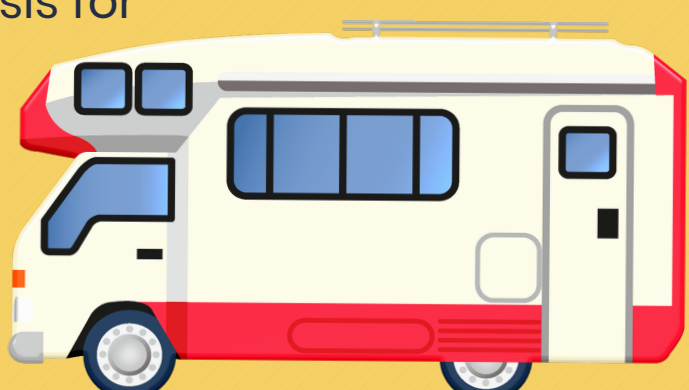
Loss

It is the stolen or damaged property and/or bodily injury that can be measured in amount and may be claimed through insurance.

6

Insurance Premium

It is an amount that an RV insurance holder pays to the insurance company on a periodic basis for the coverage provided.
